Building Perspective

The Police Service Center project included the demolition of deteriorating structures on the property for the construction of the new 30,822 square foot facility. The new center provides the county with a two-story structure with a corner entry, that houses a courtroom gallery; offices for the Chief, Assistant Chief, Captains, Chaplain, CID, LT, and SIU; Evidence and Property; Sallyport; Kennel; Briefing; Evidence Rooms; Planning Room; Records; and Employee Lounge.

Juvenile Center Addition

With the relocation of the Bradley County Justice Center to a new facility, a portion of the existing justice center was demolished and an addition added for use as a juvenile center. The addition includes two program rooms and four pods. Each pod includes a dayroom and three 2-man cells for a total of 24 occupants. Two rec yards are provided for these four pods.

The project also included minor interior renovations in the existing facility.
